

Public Summary Report DIH-HERO COVID-19 Response and Deployment Open Call 2021

Results of open call (DIH-HERO COVID-19 Response and Deployment Open Call 2021) for recipients of financial support

The DIH-HERO project, co-funded from the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme under grant agreement No 825003, launched an open call (DIH-HERO COVID-19 Response and Deployment Open Call 2021) for recipients of financial support.

The call closed on 15th of February 2022 for proposal submission. After the closure for proposal submission, the project consortium could be completed until the 15th of March 2022. At that date all 4 end-users involved in the deployment must have been included in the project proposal.

A total of 12 proposals from 20 countries (including the end-user locations) were received. 8 proposals will receive funding for a total amount of 1,997,454 EUR. The evaluation and selection have been completed. The proposers have been informed about the evaluation results for their proposal for financial support.

Call information

The call has been published on the 15th of October 2021 on the DIH-HERO project website (www.dih-hero.eu) and has been sent to the EC project officer 30 days before the opening of the call to be published on the Horizon 2020 Participants Portal (https://ec.europa.eu/info/funding-tenders/opportunities/portal/screen/opportunities/competitive-calls) on the 27th of August 2021.

Dates of call publication and closing, evaluation and selection

The COVID-19 Response and Deployment Open Call 2021 within the DIH-HERO project has been opened on the 15th of October 2021. The call has been planned to be opened for proposal submission period of 4 months, were the period for completion of project consortium was opened for an additional (1) month. The evaluation and the selection of all proposals took place after the closure of the call.

All questions asked by proposers in regard to the COVID-19 Response Open Call 2021 have been answered in the FAQ section of the website, in order to make the same information accessible to all proposers at the same time. All proposers were informed on the evaluation results by email.
